



EU-Jordan Strategic and Comprehensive Partnership

The **EU and Jordan** are stepping up their cooperation to the level of a **Strategic and Comprehensive Partnership**.

To support this partnership, the EU is proposing a **financial package of €3 billion** for Jordan for **2025-2027**. This includes:

€640 million
in grants

around **€1.4 billion**
of **additional investments**

€1 billion
in concessional loans
(**macro-financial assistance**)

The Partnership focuses on **5 key areas** of common interest:



Political relations & regional cooperation

- Sharing a commitment to the promotion of peace, security and stability in the Middle East and the Mediterranean region at large
- Further promoting democracy, rule of law, good governance, human rights, fundamental freedoms and non-discrimination
- Holding an EU-Jordan Summit once every two years on top of the regular annual working visits
- Keep collaborating in the framework of the Union for the Mediterranean



Security & defence

- Boosting dialogue and cooperation on common security challenges including terrorism and violent extremism, hybrid threats and drug trafficking, and enhancing cooperation with EU agencies
- Supporting the Jordanian Armed Forces, including through the European Peace Facility
- Fighting together organised crime and illegal smuggling, as well as cybersecurity threats



Economic resilience, trade & investments

- Supporting structural reforms conducive to economic growth and employment
- Promoting sustainable trade and investments in multiple sectors and unleashing the full potential of the Free Trade Area of the Association Agreement
- Promoting water, energy and green transition for a resource-efficient green economy
- Enhancing cooperation on digitalisation, entrepreneurship, innovation and job creation



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Human capital

- Bridging the gap skills and promoting inclusivity to foster entrepreneurship and formal job creation
- Promoting quality education and skills creation through vocational technical education and training



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Migration, protection of & support to refugees

- Strengthening the EU-Jordan dialogue on migration, refugees and mobility issues in a comprehensive manner
- Continue working on durable solutions for refugees (including complementary pathways for protection and safe voluntary and dignified returns), also in cooperation with international agencies
- Strengthening cooperation on border management, fight against smuggling and trafficking in human beings
